Pro – Latin Prefix: **before, forward, for, forth, first**

In the story *No Gift for Man*, Prometheus was a Titan whose name meant forward thinking. Study how the prefix PRO is used in the words below and then follow the links to complete the Morpho Match games:

Note: Observe how sometimes the o in PRO sounds open/long and sometimes it sounds closed/short.

Word	Meaning
profess	To speak forth or declare. -I will <i>profess</i> my love for him.
pro and con	for and against -He made a list of <i>pros and cons</i> .
propel	to push or move forward -Kick your legs to <i>propel</i> yourself through the water.
propellant	A fuel that pushes something forward -Which <i>propellant</i> should we use for our rocket?
product	something produced or brought forth -They are selling a brand-new <i>product</i> .
protect	to shield from danger before something happens. -He got a shot to <i>protect</i> himself from the flu.
progress	movement in a forward direction. -He is making <i>progress</i> on his report.
pronoun	A word that stands for a noun: <i>I, he, she, you, it, they</i> Try to replace her name with a <i>pronoun</i> .
